## History

*On February 2, 2006, Feast of the Presentation of Our Lord, the Archbishop Emeritus Gaudencio B. Cardinal Rosales, DD of the Roman Catholic Archbishop of Manila (RCAM) established the Archdiocese of Manila Office of Exorcism (AMOE) under the umbrella of the Archdiocesan Commission on Extraordinary Phenomena, in order to address the growing number of cases who need liberation from extraordinary demonic attacks and bondages.*

## History

*Spiritual Liberation and Exorcism falls under the Ministry of the Sick. This entails a program that encompasses not only diagnostic procedures and the prayer for spiritual liberation and exorcism itself, but must also include proper follow-ups and evaluations. The whole thrust of this ministry is to guide the afflicted person or energumen to grow in holiness by bringing him to an intimate relationship with Jesus. This may necessitate exorcism prayers, guidance and counseling, evangelization of the person and his family, introduction to a community where the energumen can find support and regular evaluation of progress in both his spiritual life and liberation. Therefore, the Case Officers (CO) with the direct guidance of the Chief Exorcist, Rev. Fr. Jose Francisco C. Syquia, journey with the energumens until they are completely liberated or strong enough to carry on a loving relationship with God.*





The **Philippine Association of Catholic Exorcists** (PACE) is a duly recognized Catholic Association in RCAM, under the guidance of His Eminence Luis Antonio G. Cardinal Tagle, DD, and the Catholic Bishops Conference of the Philippines (CBCP) under the Episcopal Commissions on Doctrine of the Faith and the Liturgy. The PACE currently has 105 registered canonically mandated priest-exorcist members nationwide and it is now officially affiliated with the Vatican approved International Association of Exorcists (IAE).

PACE promotes spiritual training, formation, and enrichment through institutes, seminars, conferences, meetings, fraternal reunions, and suitable projects by which the priestly life and growth in the ministry of spiritual liberation and exorcism are strengthened. It also enables members to find mutual help in cultivating their intellectual and spiritual life as it relates to the ministry of spiritual liberation and exorcism, thus, promoting better cooperation among themselves in their ministry (*Presbyterorum Ordinis*, no.8), and enabling the members, priests and lay collaborators, to be of mutual help and protection to one other.

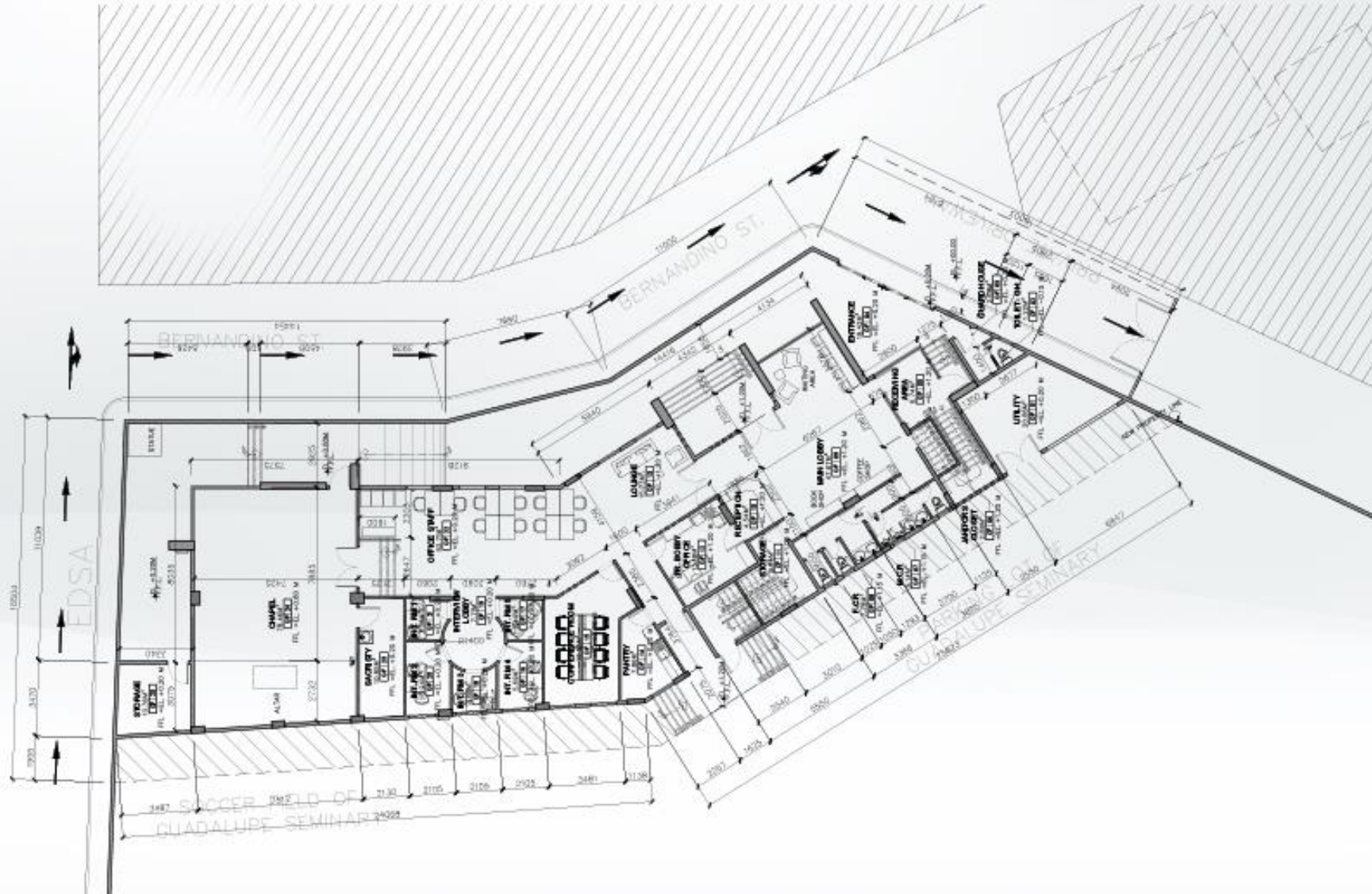

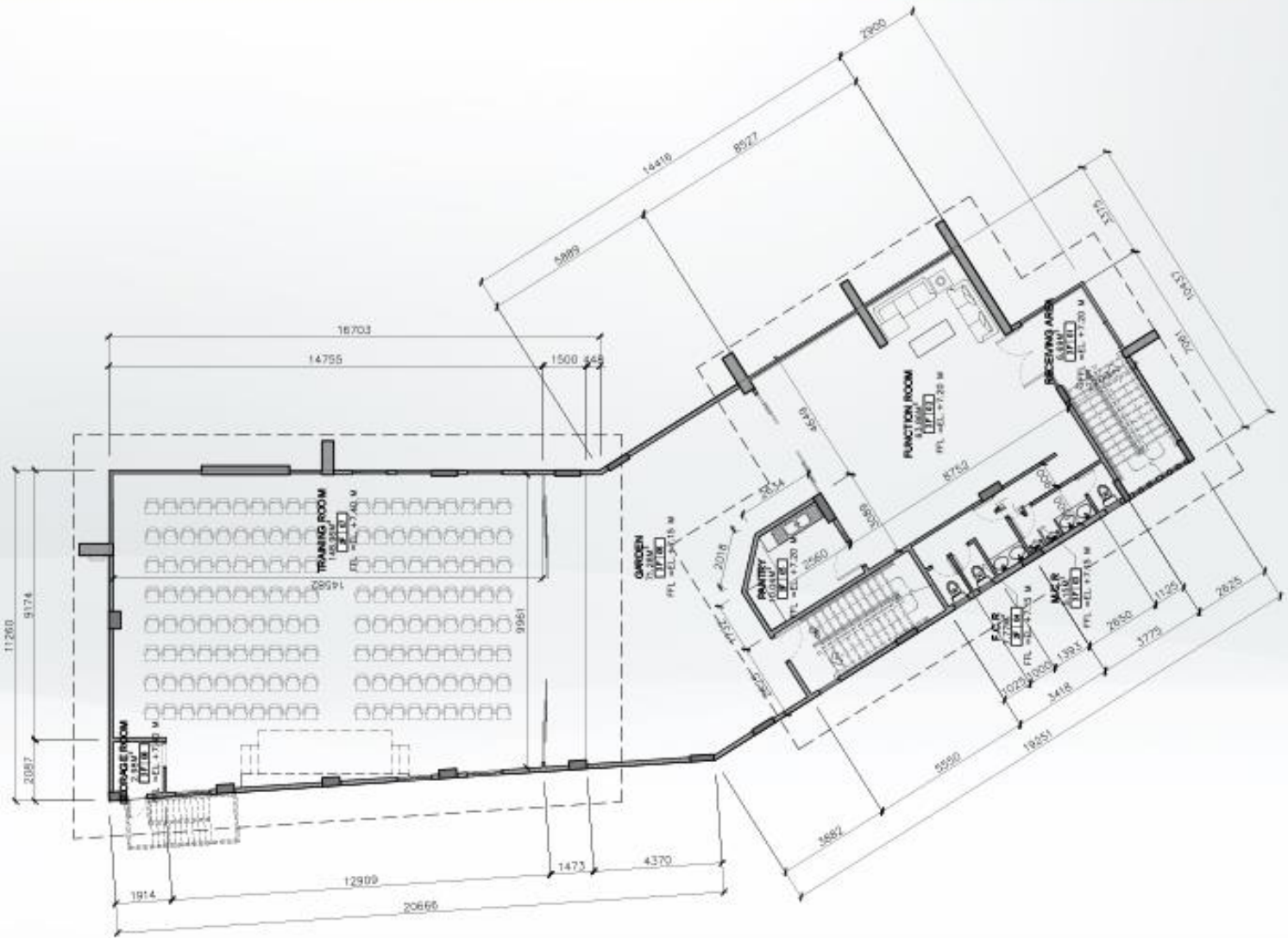
# Ground Floor Plan







# Third Floor Plan

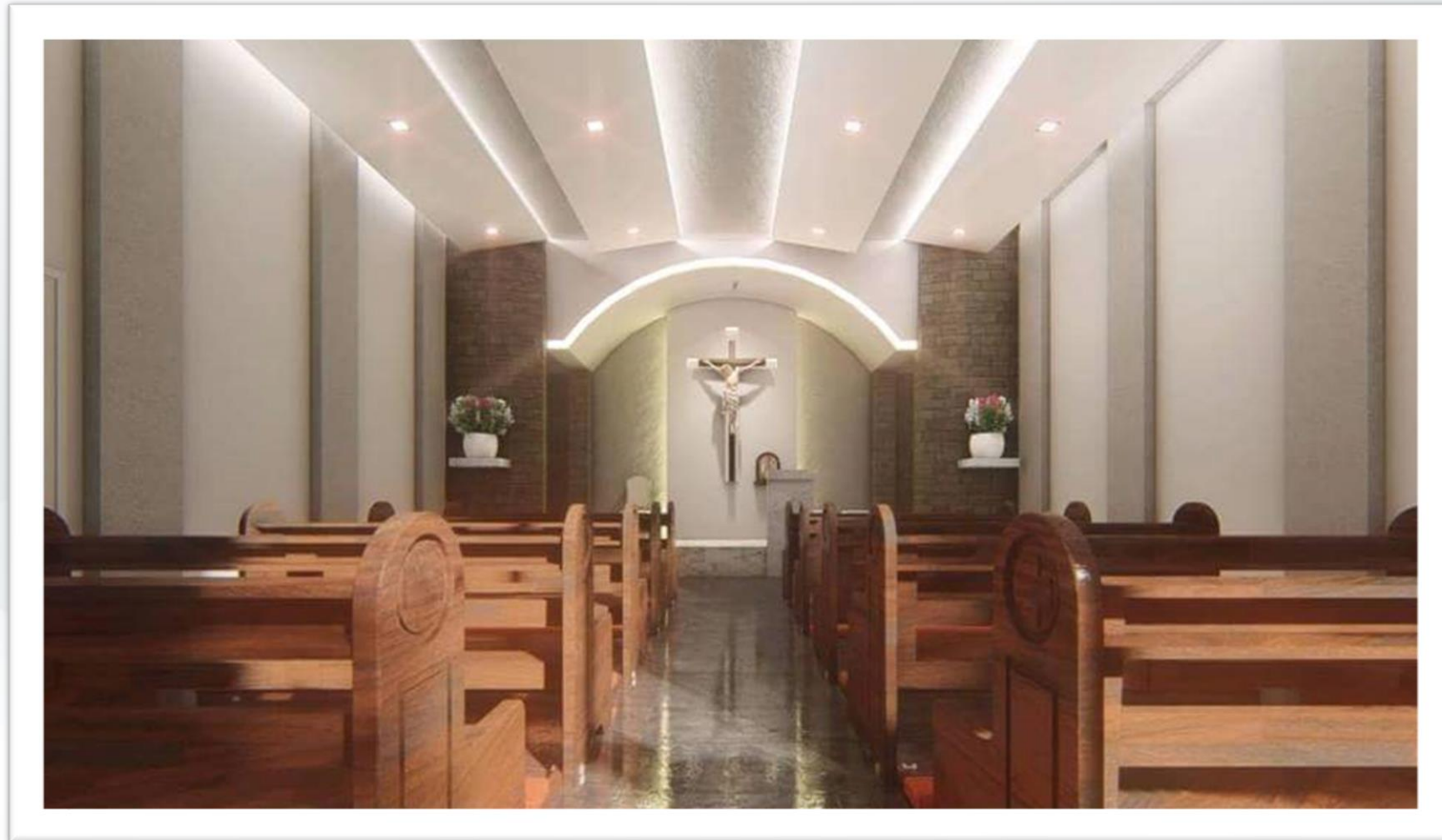




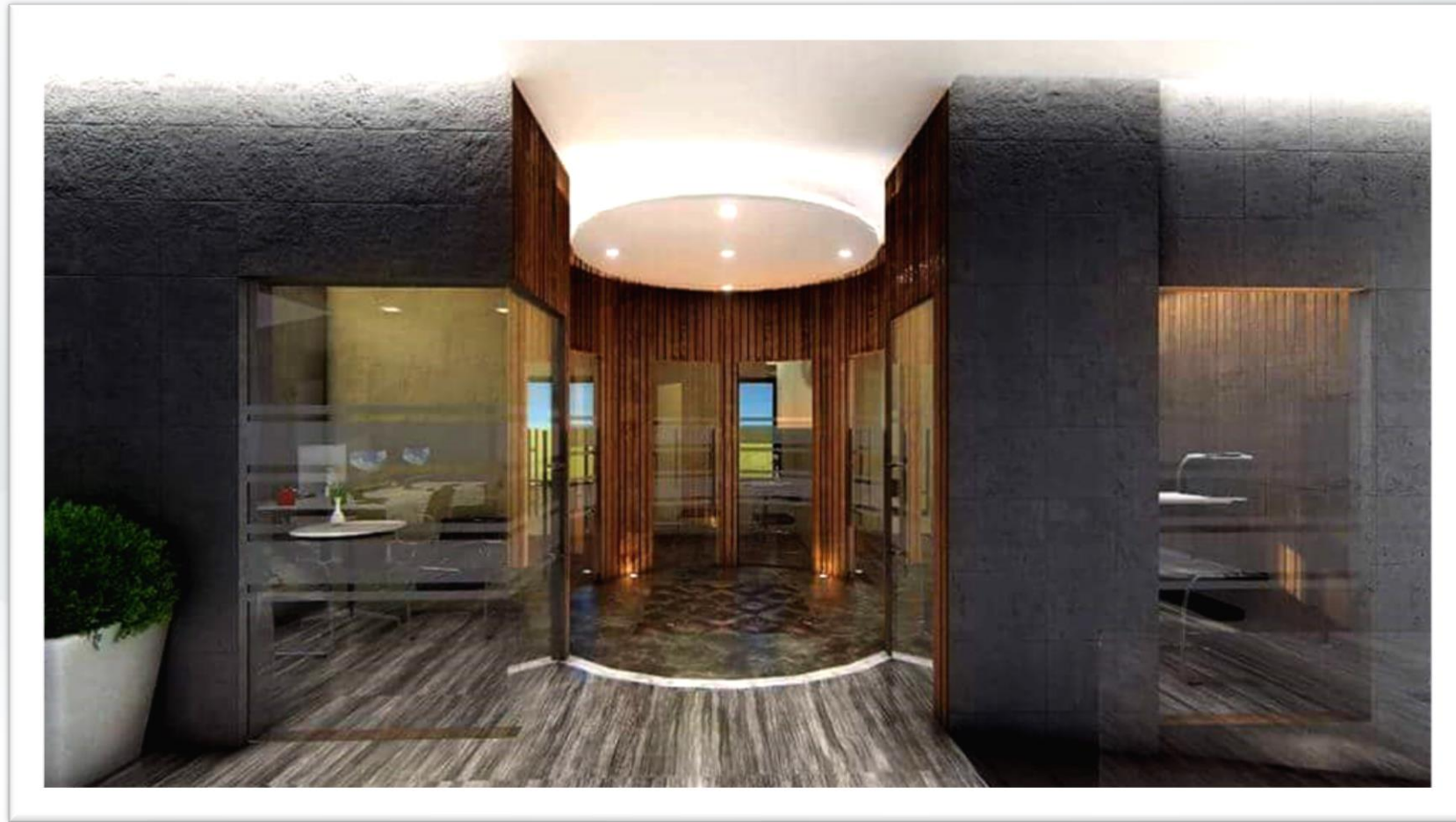
